THE EPIPHONE STORY

For over 140 years, Epiphone has been a leading innovator in designing professional affordable musical instruments. Whether you're a pro or just starting out, Epiphone has a guitar, bass, or acoustic instrument made with you in mind.

The roots of Epiphone go back to the Stathopoulo family from Sparta, Greece, who began building instruments in 1873. The family settled in Manhattan in the early 1920s where Epiphone founder Epi Stathopoulo, a second generation luthier, built a Manhattan showroom as both an exhibition hall and a gathering place for the best musicians of the day including innovator Les Paul. Les built his first "Les Paul" solid body guitar at the Epiphone factory on 14th street.

Throughout the first half of the 20th century, Epi patented numerous breakthrough designs for banjos, upright basses, and both acoustic and electric guitars, including the Masterbilt acoustic guitar. In 1957, at the urging of Les Paul, the Stathopoulo family merged with its foremost competitor, Gibson. Over the next decade, a new line of Epiphone acoustic and electric instruments were again embraced by artists in every genre including The Beatles, The Rolling Stones, The Kinks, John Lee Hooker, Roy Orbison, The Who, Jimmy Page, Jimi Hendrix, and Johnny Winter.

Today from its state-of-the-art headquarters in Nashville, TN, Epiphone instruments are helping a new generation make music history. Epiphone is the official instrument of Rocksmith 2014, the critically acclaimed video experience that's teaching millions around the world how to play guitar and bass. The new and innovative PRO-1™ Collection is the first in a new series of guitars designed by pros to be easy to play. And once again, the great artists of our time like Gary Clark Jr., Paul McCartney, Slash, Joe Bonamassa, Tak Matsumoto, Jack Casady, Lee Malia, Dwight Yoakam, Alabama Shakes, FUN., Matt Heafy, Vampire Weekend, Brendon Small, and Tommy Thayer of KISS and many others count on Epiphone for our history of quality and innovation. In 2014, Epiphone fully introduced four incredible new pickups, the ProBucker™, the Alnico Classic PRO™, the single coil P-90 PRO™ and the Ceramic Plus™ that for the first time, made the sound of hand-made boutique pickups affordable to everyone. Whether you're looking for a classic tone or something new, Epiphone's new line of premier pickups can take you there.

ProBucker™ Humbucker

Epiphone's ProBucker humbucker has quietly become one of the most talked about pickups in the industry. It has fooled experts, vintage purists, and even luthiers who have worked with the best vintage examples from the late 50s and early 60s. Epiphone ProBucker humbuckers are the real deal–made with 18% Nickel Silver unit bases and covers, the same alloy used by Gibson at the Kalamazoo factory when the humbucker was first invented. The use of Nickel Silver reduces the occurrence of eddy currents due to low conductivity and provides a more transparent and crisp output. The size and shape of the bobbins also has a great impact on tonal response. And the bobbins used on ProBucker pickups duplicate the size and shape of the gold standard in the industry, Gibson humbuckers. Epiphone ProBucker pickups also feature sand cast Alnico II magnets, high quality 4 conductor lead wire, and are vacuum wax potted to eliminate microphonics.

But what really counts is the sound, For Richard Akers, Epiphone's Director of Research and Development, securing Epiphone a place in the crowded race to produce a great Patent Applied For-style humbucker was the ultimate design challenge. "The new ProBucker pickups are not just slight improvements over previously produced pickups. They were completely designed here in Nashville and tooled from the ground-up at a new factory dedicated to high end pickup production," said Akers. "These pickups use only the highest quality components and are based on the most sought after humbuckers of Gibson's history. I spent many, many hours making sure these came out great and I am really happy with the results. They sound fantastic."

During Epiphone's 140th birthday celebration during an open house that saw many – including some of the top guitar magazine editors in the US – take the "humbucker challenge" and pick Epiphone over many other fine boutique challengers. While every pickup sounded fantastic and the differences were slight, Epiphone's ProBuckers were chosen as the preferred pickup by a majority (61%) of the players.

Alnico Classic PRO™ Humbucker

Like ProBuckers, Epiphone's Alnico Classic PRO's are 4-conductor and use the same materials found in vintage humbuckers including Elektrisola wire, bobbins made to exact Gibson specifications and 18% Nickel/Silver unit bases and covers. But instead of Alnico-II magnets, more powerful Alnico-V magnets are used along with matched windings on each coil. The result is more emphasis on the pickup's upper midrange frequencies for enhanced crunch and sustain. Alnico Classic PRO's are perfect for any hard rock application, easily overdriving amplifiers for a beefy, sizzling output that boosts any guitar's power and presence.

Epiphone P-90 PRO™ Pickup

Following in the footsteps of the ProBucker is the new single coil P-90 PRO, a rebirth of the one of the greatest and most versatile pickups in popular music, also invented by Seth Lover. The original single coil P-90 pickup was inspired by the now legendary (and super rare) "Charlie Christian" pickup used by the revolutionary jazz guitar player from Oklahoma who plugged in with the Benny Goodman band and transformed the guitar from a rhythm instrument to a solo instrument.

Just like originals P-90s, the Epiphone P-90 PRO is an extremely sensitive pickup that easily bends to a player's unique touch. With its distinctive growl and wide range, it's great for rock and roll, pop, jazz, country, or anything you want to throw at it. "Just like a good chef uses science and art to create unique dishes, a good pickup designer is able to use ingredients in unique ways to create sound," continues Richard Akers. "All the ingredients are available to anyone willing to look but you have to know how to combine them and what is important. Knowing the ingredients in a fine family recipe and how they combine is very similar to how I went about producing these pickups that are synonymous with what our ears have evolved to know as the sound of Rock and Roll."

The new Epiphone P-90 PRO single coil pickups are also made with 18% Nickel Silver covers and have been designed and tooled from the ground up with new bobbins manufactured to historic dimensions, Elektrisola magnet wire, sand cast Alnico V magnets, and pole shoes manufactured using correct alloys and to Gibson dimensions. And for you sticklers to detail, the new Epiphone P-90 PROs also have tin plated brass base plates like used on 50's and 60's era Gibson P-90 pickups.

Ceramic Plus™ Humbucker

The Ceramic Plus humbucker is the next step in the House of Stathopoulo's ongoing crusade to merge the tone of the past with the tone of the future. Like Epiphone's critically acclaimed ProBucker pickups, new Ceramic Plus humbuckers feature 18% Nickel silver unit bases, bobbins tooled to exact Gibson specifications, Elektrisola Magnet wire, but instead are powered by Ceramic 8 magnets.

Epiphone's new Ceramic Plus humbuckers are high output modern pickups designed to provide a tight low-end response with both a smooth mid-range and a slightly more pronounced cut on the top end. Ceramic Plus pickups provide high output while still maintaining clarity and focus that's perfect for metal and hard driving rock. Ceramic Plus™ pickups also shine with incredible sustain, drive, and harmonic content at high volume. Modern hi-wattage amps are an especially good match with Ceramic Plus pickups, providing all the color and character of a classic humbucker but with the cutting drive that can keep up with intense volumes, fast and super articulate players, and more efficient modern amps.

Ceramic pickups provide an excellent alternative to Alnico pickups with their with their sharp, articulate, and more saturated tone. "The physics dictates that when the impedance of a pickup increases the high end frequency response of the pickup decreases. As the need to drive amps further into saturation became desirable the use of Ceramic magnets to compensate for this loss of frequency response became a perfect fit," said Epiphone's Richard Akers. "Simply increasing the impedance of a pickup while maintaining the use of Alnico magnets in most cases creates a muddy sounding pickup that lacks clarity. The use of ceramic magnets helps to compensate for this and adds clarity and focus to high output pickups" With Epiphone's Ceramic Plus open coil humbucker pickups, Epiphone once again puts a new twist on the legendary Les Paul sound.







Every acoustic instrument has specific requirements and properties that must be met in order to ensure the player the musical experience they desire.

Epiphone engineers have sought to identify and qualify these attributes in order to incorporate them into our product.

Of course, offering the public a selection of instruments that accommodates all of the various musical styles is only part of the equation. Each instrument must have correct geometry that allows for easy playability and good tone...regardless of the price point. The diligent work of our engineers and quality teams has ensured that we are able to maintain consistent quality of materials, construction, fit and finish and tone throughout our product line.

Masterbilt™ Acoustics

For the more discerning musician, we have developed our Masterbilt line. This line harkens back to the Golden Age of Epiphone Guitars, when they were offering the best instruments available for the working professionals of the day. Great attention to detail is paid to every aspect of these instruments. They all offer solid wood construction throughout. Solid Sitka Spruce or Solid Cedar is used for the tops for each Masterbilt. These solid tops sound good today and will continue to improve as they are played. Braces are made from tight grained, quarter sawn Spruce, glued in with hide glue and are shaped and scalloped to established standards, in order to produce a rich, balanced tone. Back and sides are book matched sets in Mahogany, Rosewood or Maple depending on model. Mahogany kerfed lining is used on all models

The necks are Solid Mahogany with Rosewood fingerboards. They are attached to the body using a tapered dovetail neck joint and "Hot Hide Glue". The Hide Glue transfers vibrations exceptionally well, and allows for easier repairs later in its life... just in case your grandson finally needs to reset the neck on your favorite guitar.

NanoFlex™ Pickup

The invention of the NanoFlex pickup technology is the latest and by far the most important step in pickup technology since the first guy wrapped wire around a magnet to produce an electromagnetic field. The term "NanoFlex" refers to its ultra thin (nano-like) profile and its flexibility that allows it to conform to any surface shape. This assures complete guitar-to-pickup-to-saddle contact.

Unlike other under-saddle pickups, the NanoFlex design utilizes 7 highly sensitive and ultra-responsive layers of sensor material to not only sense the vibrations of the strings but the vibrations of the guitar body as well. The NanoFlex is the first pickup to incorporate active amplification directly at the pickup. As a result, the signal does not pass through even a single millimeter of the wire, and therefore, the signal quality is uncompromised. Combined with its 100% shielding, the NanoFlex is absolutely and completely noise free. This is different from all other acoustic pickup technology.

NanoMag™ Pickup

Ordinary magnetic pickups have been used successfully to amplify electric guitars for years but when used to amplify acoustic guitars, they fail to deliver

desirable acoustic response. That's because magnetic pickups have a very narrow bandwidth with an over-emphasis on mid-range frequencies.

The NanoMag, referring to its small size and its composition, is a completely new kind of magnetic pickup that combines 3 Samarium-Cobalt magnets with on-board, active electronics to produce a low-impedance pickup with absolute linear response and an uncharacteristically wide frequency range.

Because ordinary under-saddle or transducer pickups fail to capture the very high and very low harmonic content, the true acoustic character of the instrument is lost. The NanoMag is able to capture all the harmonics - from the lowest to the highest - with incredible accuracy. All with ZERO noise or artificial coloration. This again is different from all other acoustic pickup technology.

NanoFlex™/NanoMag™ Combination

While each pickup individually outperforms all others, the combination of the two is extraordinary. The NanoFlex captures string and body vibrations while the NanoMag, mounted at the harmonic-rich end of the fingerboard, captures all the string energy and lush harmonic content. Now, the acoustic guitar has never sounded so real and alive with all its subtle nuances and distinct characteristics.

eSonic™ and eSonic2 Preamp Controls and Functions

Both eSonic and eSonic2 preamps are equipped with a Master Volume control, used to control the output level or "loudness" of our NanoFlex or NanoMag/NanoFlex combo equipped acoustic/electrics. The eSonic is equipped with 3 EQ controls, (Treble, Bass & Dynamics slider) that work together with each other to shape the overall "tone" of the instrument.

The Dynamics slider reduces or increases the range of the treble and bass controls. The dynamic control also alters the EQ shape allowing you to best tailor the sound of your guitar to fit your style of playing, the volume level and the venue.

The eSonic2 is equipped with individual EQ controls for each pickup. They are: Mag EQ (NanoMag) and Flex EQ (NanoFlex). Each control operates in the same way by increasing treble up to 9bB or increasing bass up to 9dB. However, these controls are not linear in that other frequencies (in particular midranges) are adjusted as well. This "variable" EQ control allows you to better "shape" the sound.

The Blend control on the eSonic2 is your "mixer" between the NanoFlex and the NanoMag pickups. Use it to control the overall tone of the instrument as well as control the signals coming out of the Stereo outputs. By using it in combination with the EQ controls, you can really tailor the sound of the guitar to fit your playing style, venue and volume level.

Both eSonic preamps also feature a Phase button and Chromatic Tuner. The Phase button inverts the output signal allowing the eSonic to compensate for acoustic phase differences that occur between instrument and speaker. This is very useful if you experience any "feedback." If you start to hear feedback, depress the phase button to immediately "cancel" the signals. The very accurate and stable Tuner will take care that you will never play out of tune as it shows note and tune status. When you turn the tuner on it also mutes the output.
